**Department of Health:**

**Three Additional O'ahu Deaths and 100 New Cases**

Three (3) O'ahu men are the latest people to pass away from coronavirus. All three had underlying medical conditions. Two were in the 60 to 69-year-old age group and the third was in the 70 to 79-year-old age group. Their deaths increase Hawaii's death toll to 91.

The DOH is aware of six (6) additional deaths associated with COVID-19 at the Yukio Okutsu Veterans Home in Hilo. To confirm these deaths, the department is waiting on medical records from the facility. Confirmation of all COVID-19 deaths is based on medical documentation.

## Laboratory\* Testing Data

There were 1,486 additional COVID-19 tests reported via electronic laboratory reporting. No additional surge testing laboratory results have been received by DOH. As a result, the reported numbers for surge testing remain the same.

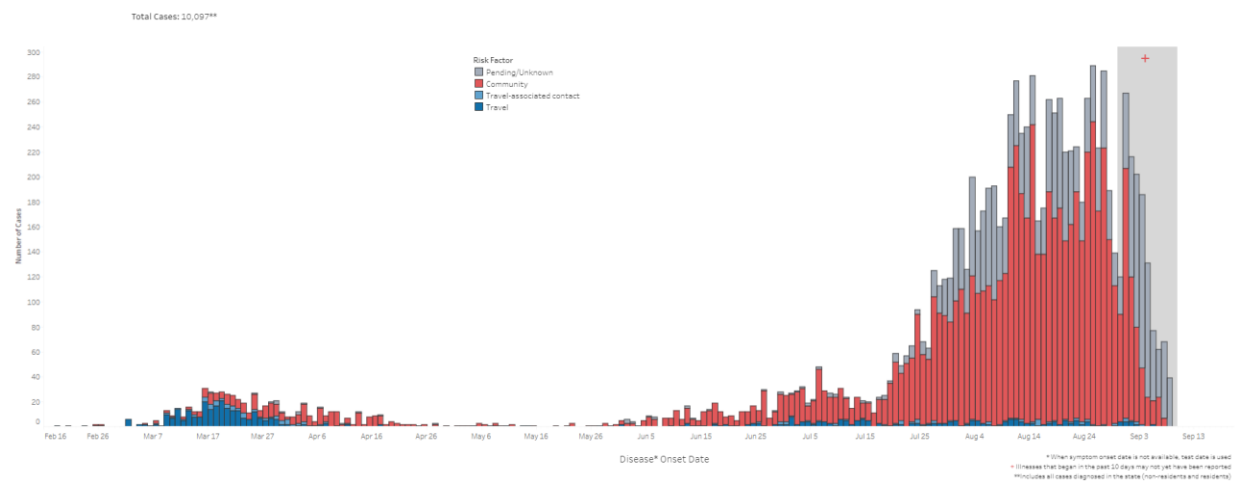
