





75 COVID-19 Cases and One Death Reported

DOH reports 75 new cases of coronavirus today and one (1) additional death, raising the state's COVID-19 death toll to 325. The victim is a Maui woman, 70-79 yds, who died in the hospital with underlying conditions.

Inmate and Staff Testing Continues

The Halawa Correctional Facility (HCF) reports 32 more inmates have recovered. That drops the total active inmate cases to 30 and increases total inmate recoveries to 512. There are five (5) hospitalized HCF inmates. There was one (1) new positive HCF staff case reported today. The Oʻahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) reported 40 negative inmate results. The Maui Community Correctional Center reported one (1) negative inmate results. The Hawaiʻi Community Correctional Center reported six (6) negative inmate results. 5,507 Passengers Arrive on Tuesday

Yesterday, a total of 5,507 people arrived in Hawai'i from out of state. A total 2,073 people indicated they came to Hawai'i for vacation. There were also 1,162 returning residents. The trans-Pacific passenger arrival data is derived from data provided by the Safe Travels digital system.
