

▲ 8,224 from previous day (2/24/2021)




# Weekly Hawaii COVID-19 Vaccine Summary

# **Statewide Inmate Testing Continues**

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. The total active positive inmate cases at the Maui Community Correctional Center remain unchanged at 26. All other correctional facility inmate populations remain clear of the virus. The O'ahu Community Correctional Center (OCCC) reported 25 negative inmate test results. ### 10,561 Passengers Arrive on Wednesday

### **HTA Visitor Statistics Report**

In January 2021, visitor arrivals dropped 80.1 percent compared to a year ago, according to preliminary statistics released by the Hawai'i Tourism Authority's Tourism Research Division. Last month, a total of 171,976 visitors traveled to Hawai'i by air service, compared to 862,574 visitors who came by air service and cruise ships in January 2020.
