



# **Unemployment Insurance Benefits Extensions Update**

DLIR announced over the weekend that programming updates and federal funding have allowed the department to offer a choice of either Extended Benefits (EB20) or Pandemic Unemployment Emergency Compensation (PEUC) for claimants who filed for EB20 between Dec. 15, 2020 and Dec. 28, 2020. The Continued Assistance Act (CAA) was signed into law extending Coronavirus, Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act unemployment provisions last month. The department has already sent emails to claimants who filed in that time frame. The claimants will have until Friday, Feb. 5 at 5:30 p.m. to choose one of the two options. Those who do not respond will automatically be processed for EB20. #### 6,997 Passengers Arrive on Sunday

Yesterday, a total of 6,997 people arrived in Hawai'i from out of state. A total 3,432 people indicated they came to Hawai'i for vacation. There were also 1,155 returning residents. The trans-Pacific passenger arrival data is derived from data provided by the Safe Travels digital system.
