

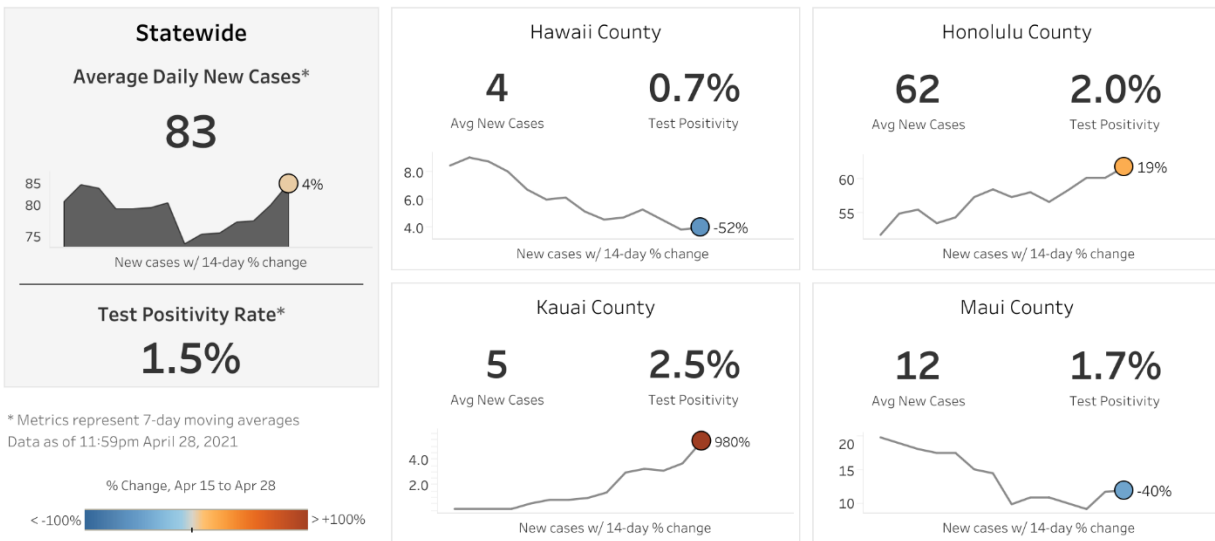

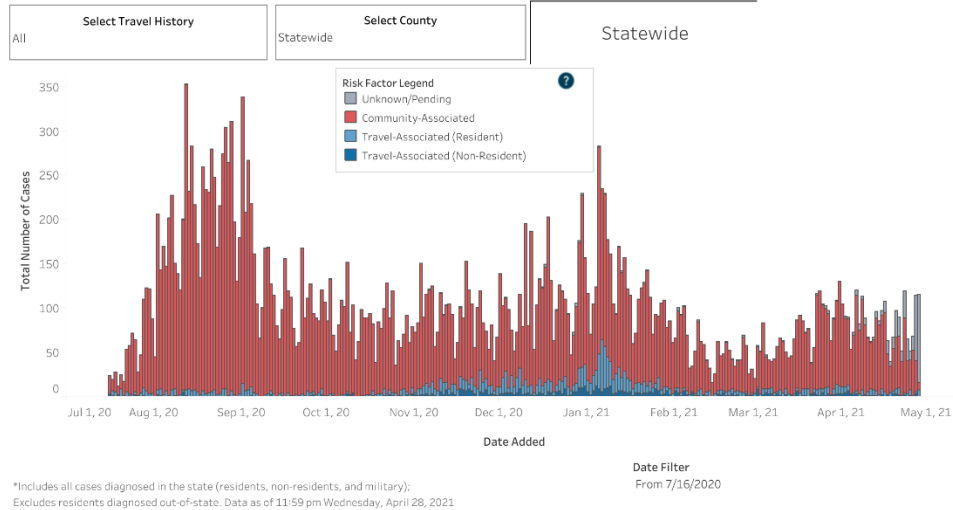

**Inmate Population Clear of COVID-19, Statewide Inmate Testing Continues**

COVID-19 testing is continuously being conducted statewide at all facilities. There are currently no active COVID-19 cases in the inmate population. There were 44 negative inmate test results reported for the Maui Community Correctional Center and 17 negative inmate test results for the O’ahu Community Correctional Center. **20,212 Passengers Arrive on Thursday**

Yesterday, a total of 20,212 people arrived in Hawai’i from out of state. A total 13,483 people indicated they came to Hawai’i for vacation. There were also 1,646 returning residents. The trans-Pacific passenger arrival data is derived from data provided by the Safe Travels digital system.
