**Free COVID Testing Available at Four New O‘ahu Sites**

HONOLULU – The Hawai‘i Department of Health (DOH) has added four new COVID-19 testing locations on O‘ahu. Testing is available at:

- ElixRX Pharmacy Kailua on Monday-Saturday from 9 a.m. – 3:30 p.m.
- Kaiser Permanente Nanaikeola Clinic Parking on Sundays and Mondays from 9 a.m.– 4 p.m.
- Mililani Recreational Center 6 on Mondays, Wednesdays, Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays from 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.
- Pearl City Shopping Center on Tuesday-Saturday from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m.

Testing is offered by DOH, the National Kidney Foundation of Hawaii Consortium and independent pharmacies. The four O‘ahu sites join seven neighbor island sites participating in the program.

Pre-registration at [PreventCOVIDHI.com](https://www.preventcovidhi.com) is recommended. Testing sites offer PCR mid-turbinate testing. Results are expected to be provided the same day via email.
